Opener, Middle Break

Four ladies' chain across you roll away and circle left
Four ladies' roll away and then you circle left around, and you go
Allemande left and weave

\*I'm singin' to the world, it's time we let the spirit come in **Swing and Promenade** (Let it come on in)
I'm singin' to the world, everybody's caught in the spin
Look at where we've been

Figure (Twice for Heads. Twice for Sides)
Heads (Sides) Promenade halfway you go square through four
Go all the way, do a right and left thru

Veer left, couples circulate

Half tag, scoot back and you go

Swing your corner, promenade home

And let it shine, shine, shine

All around the world
