Figure (reverse progression):

Head/Side Ladies Chain, Heads/Sides Square Thru 3

Separate Around 1 to a Line, Star Thru

Double Pass Thru, 1st Couple go Left, 2nd go Right

Pass the Ocean, Girls Circulate Boys Run Promenade
